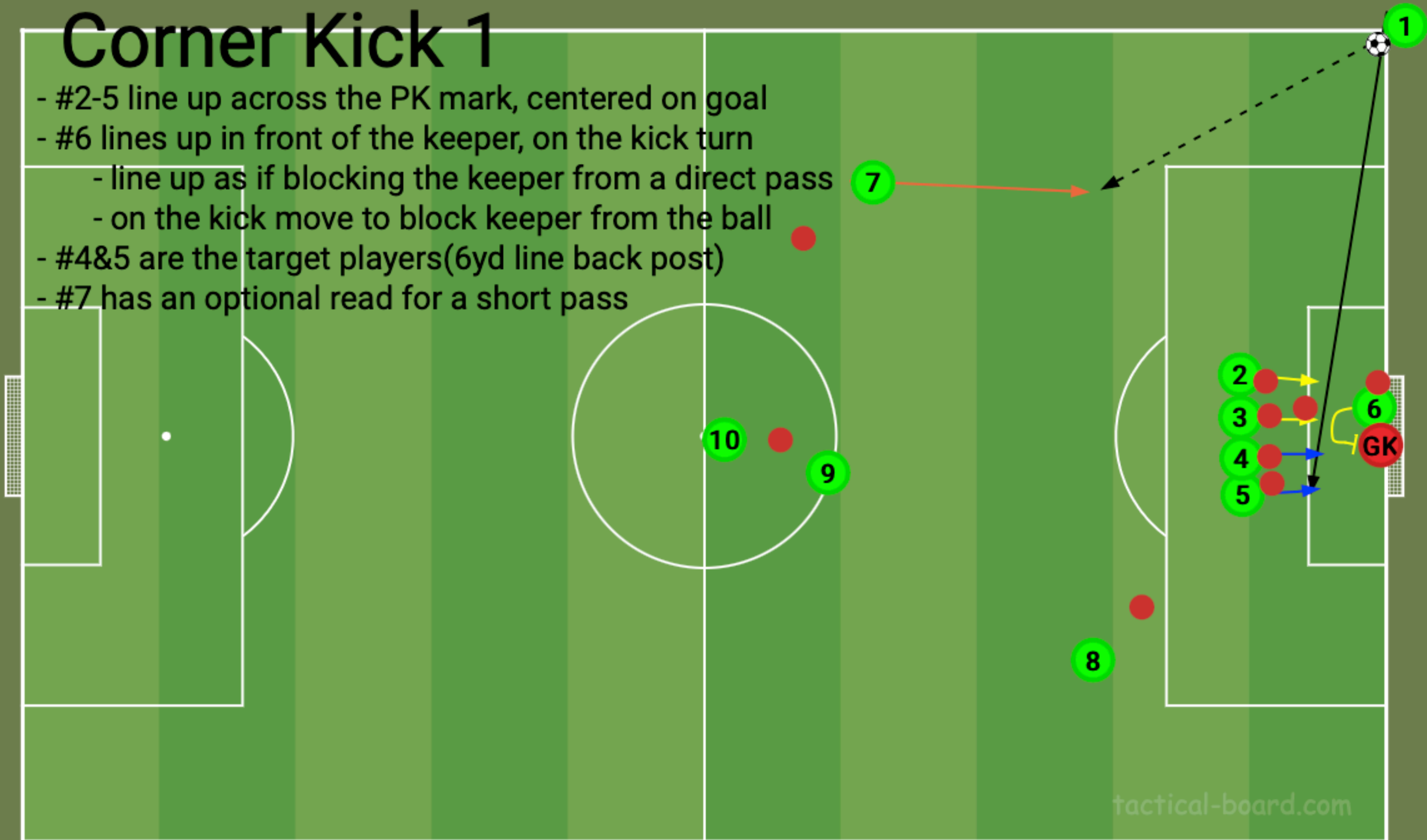


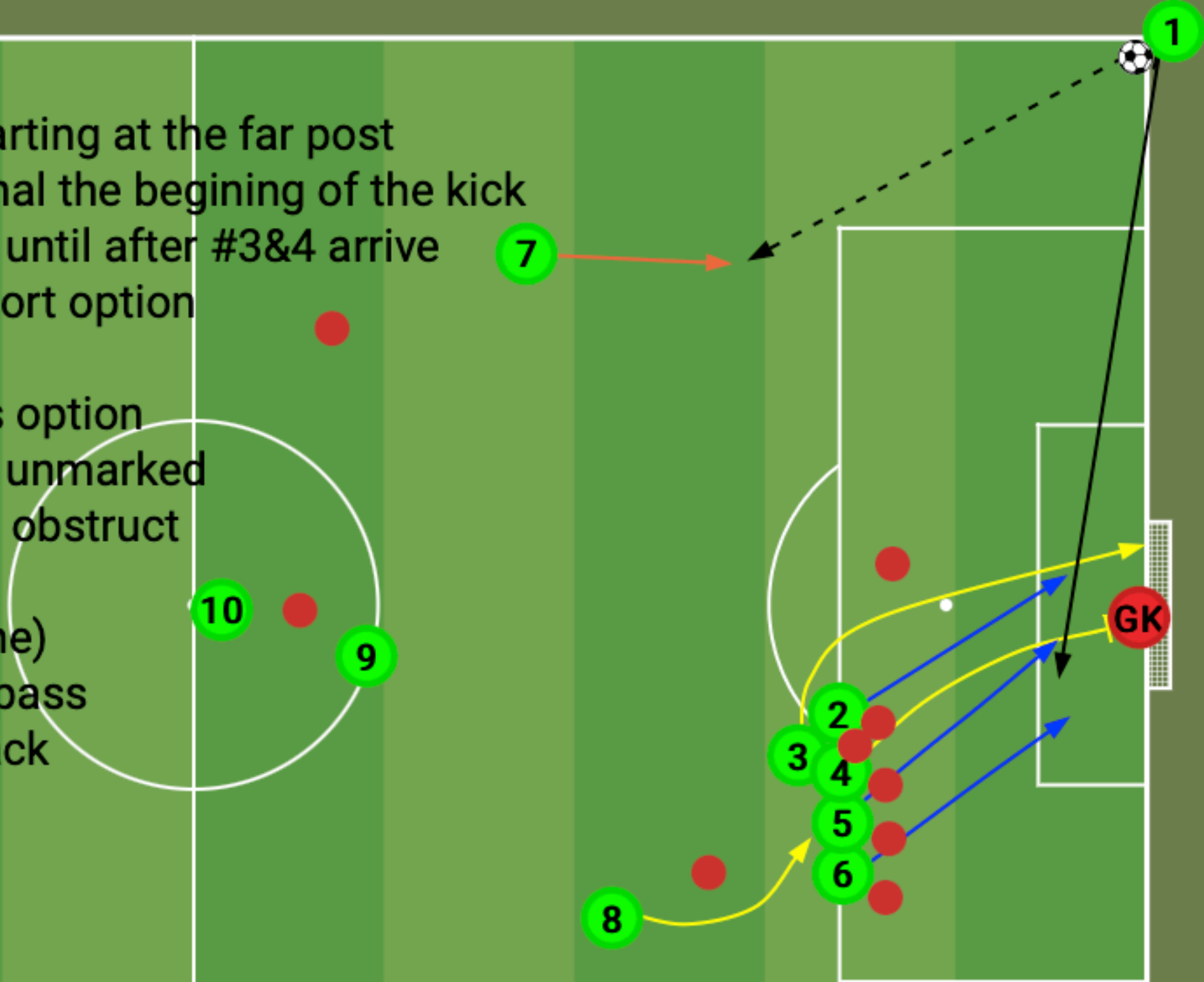
Corner Kick 1

- #2-5 line up across the PK mark, centered on goal
- #6 lines up in front of the keeper, on the kick turn
 - line up as if blocking the keeper from a direct pass
 - on the kick move to block keeper from the ball
- #4&5 are the target players(6yd line back post)
- #7 has an optional read for a short pass



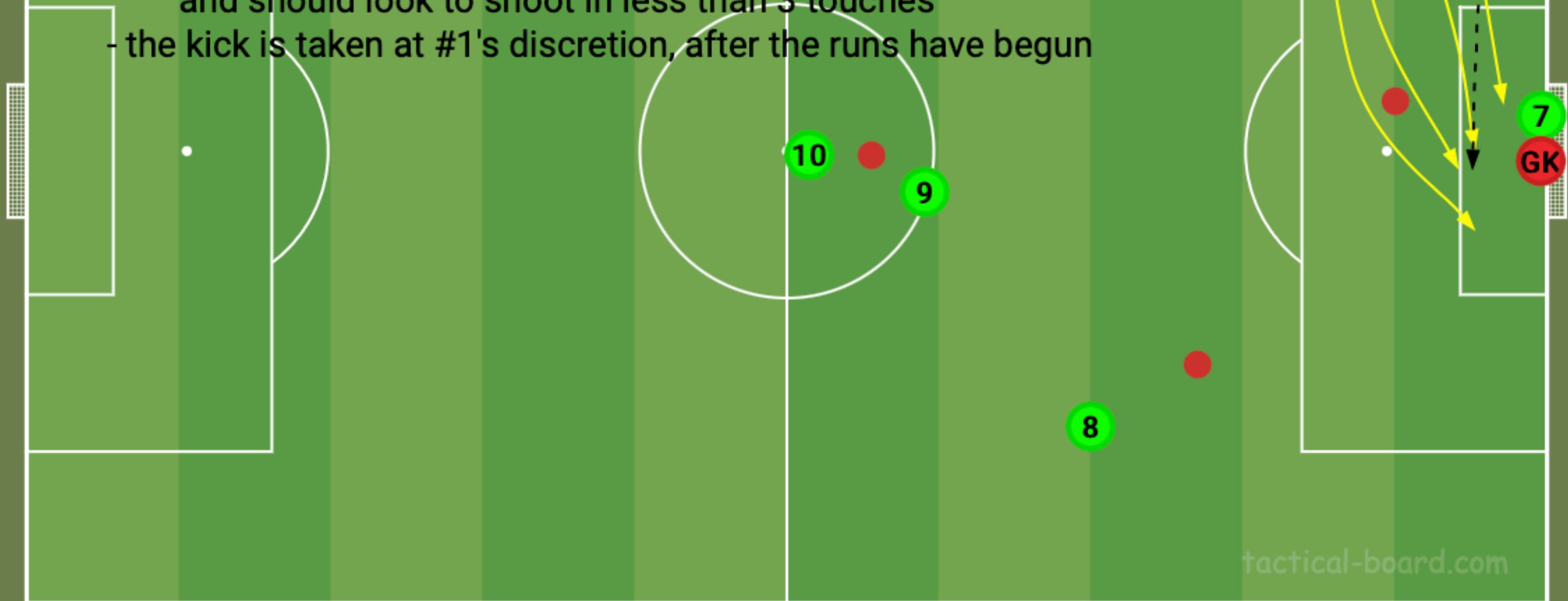
Corner Kick 2

- #2-6 line up across the 18yd line starting at the far post
- #3&4 both make early runs that signal the begining of the kick
 - #1 does not begin kick aproach until after #3&4 arrive
 - #3 runs to the near post as a short option or to block keeper
 - #3 is only a short early pass option if he moves to the fron post unmarked
- #4 runs directly to the keeper to obstruct keepers path to the 6yd line
- #2,5&6 are the target players(5yd line)
- #7 has an optional read for a short pass
- #8 moves to cleanup behind the stack



Corner Kick 3 "The Peel"

- #2-6 line up on the near side edge of penalty area
- #2-6 peel off 1-by-1
 - If the defense follows the stack outside, the target is to cross the ball onto the runs being made
 - If the defenders stay central or split up, #3 becomes the target and should look to shoot in less than 3 touches
 - the kick is taken at #1's discretion, after the runs have begun



Corner Kick 5 "Short"

- players in the stack line up on the 18yd with #6 on the near post
- #8 lines up behind the wall and should be in 1v1 coverage, may be left open
- #3,4 and 6 are dummy runs
- #2, 5 and 9 are cleanup
- #8 is the target for a header or volley
