 - Financial Report
 - Annual IRS filing complete for FY 2022 (ending Apr 2023) 990-N
 - Additional paperwork is required for this year's tax filing in April as it will be our third consecutive year that we have had fundraising activities exceed \$50k
 - Kris has been capturing this additional level of detail needed for new paperwork (itemized income and expenses)
 - o FY 2023 likely moving to form 990-EZ due to gross receipts
 - 2023-24 Budget draft review
 - Program income (sponsorship from local businesses) last year brought in \$12,800; budgeted
 \$12k this year
 - Print fewer game programs this year (last year only used 1 box) budgeted \$1400 vs \$1642 of cost last year
 - Spirit income (t shirt sales and contribution from Rebyl) was higher last year due to selling shirts for Avian and donating to him - need to sell 350 shirts this year
 - Can we use Blast "team store" to sell extra travel gear?
 - Action: Krista will ask Jen about the online spirit wear store (last year used Rebyl).
 - Last year sponsorship and concessions exceeded expectations need to start reaching out to sponsors
 - Need to push car wash card sales (sold around 300 last year, can we sell 400 this year?) need to sell 10 cards/player. Decision: Incentive sales: Sell 10 cards and player gear is
 covered. Give a deadline for when cards need to be sold. Action: Adjust budget to reflect this
 decision.
 - Blast income not included in budget preference is to not budget whatever we get is good and learning for future years
 - We will need to provide Blast with our goal for this year at some point
 - Cub Foods only did one weekend last year. Action: Krista will ask Liz to schedule two weekends now
 - We already have the \$2000 worth of spirit wear
 - Left off website costs due to switching from SportsEngine to Blast.
 - o Budgeted more for event nights to amplify the events from last year.

- JV/Varsity will play in the Federated Classic (Owatonna). Will play Duluth there so will not need to travel to Duluth. Will change the Duluth trip line item to Owatonna. Will return to St Cloud/St John's in 2024-25.
- No parent contributions budgeted for travel gear.
- Need to add \$2250 for alternate uniforms.
- Need to add \$2000 for coaches gear. (\$250/coach)
- Hudl is paid for by the athletic director so not in budget this year.
- Final draft due at next meeting (Sept 6)
