Uniform Replacement Fee Agreement

As uniforms deteriorate and are in a state of disrepair, the Marquette Boys Lacrosse Club shall provide replacement uniforms. But these uniforms are very expensive and it is both the Athlete and the Parent or Guardian's responsibility to ensure good care is taken in washing them, caring for them, and returning them.

The parent or guardian of an athlete is responsible for the cost of the replacement of uniforms (not to exceed \$250 per incident) that are not returned by 6/1/2024 or are damaged through negligence or carelessness.

Here are some quick instructions to help you care for these uniforms:

- Heavily soiled uniforms should be soaked in cold water with a protein release agent for a MAXIMUM of 45 minutes.
- Uniforms should be washed immediately after presoaking.
- For uniform longevity and optimal results, wash uniforms immediately after each wearing.
- If washing cannot take place immediately after wearing, uniforms should be rinsed out and hung on rust-proof hangers. Color migration may occur if wet uniforms are piled for laundry, or placed in travel bags while wet or damp.
- "Eye black" seems to stain many uniforms. Please consider using Dawn dishwashing detergent to get this "grease" out of the uniforms, should your athlete stain it.

DO NOT wash in warm or ho	t water, wash ONLY in cold water.
DO NOT wash whites and co	lors together.
DO NOT use chlorine bleach	
DO NOT use fabric softener.	
USE a mild detergent (ph une	der 10.0ph)
For best results allow garmer	nts to hang dry (particularly those containing Spandex).
DO NOT dry with a dryer.
