Temescal Canyon Titans Soccer is aimed at building competitive student-athletes that exhibit drive, responsibility, teamwork and good sportsmanship on and off the field. Members of the team are expected to abide by the following rules:

CONDUCT: Players are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and responsible manner on the field, in the classroom and within the community. This also extends to conduct when utilizing forms of electronic communication (ie. texting, phone calls, Facebook, Twitter, etc.). Inappropriate behavior and/or discipline problems will result in loss of play time and possible removal from the team.

PARENT CONDUCT: Parents are asked to support their daughters and conduct themselves in a respectable manner at games. Parents will not be allowed on the field at games and must wait in the stands until their daughter is released. If a parent would like to speak to the coach, you can send an e-mail and we can set up a time to meet. It is recommended to wait 48 hours before any communication is made.

**ALCOHOL/DRUGS:** This program is focused on developing healthy athletes therefore the use of alcohol and/or drugs is strictly prohibited and will result in removal from the team.

ATTENDANCE: Players are expected to attend all practices, games, and team meetings. Failure to attend any team-related activity will result in a loss of play time. If a practice is missed the day before a game the player will not be allowed to play in that match. If a player misses a match they will be suspended from the next match. Players must inform the coaches if they will be unable to attend a team-related activity. As a coaching staff, we fully support our athletes' goals to play at the next level, and therefore understand absences that are a result of a college-recruiting trip or showcase — playing time may be affected, but they will not be suspended from any matches. Injured players are still obligated to attend practices and games, but will not be allowed to physically participate until released by the athletic trainer or a physician.

**ATTIRE:** Players will be required to wear their practice shirts at each practice. Wearing club apparel to practices is prohibited. Game day attire will be decided upon by the captains and coaches, and all girls are expected to participate. The team uniform will be worn properly at all times and failure to do so will result in a loss of playing time.

GRADES: CIF states that a student must maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher and be failing no more than 1 course to be eligible. If a student falls below a 2.0 during the season or is failing a course, they will be suspended from games until their grades are brought back up. Any student falling below the CIF standard will be declared academically ineligible and will be suspended for the remainder of the season.

**TRANSPORTATION:** All players must ride the team bus to and from games — exceptions can be made after talking with the coaching staff. For tournaments, players will be given the option to be driven by a parent, but only after the appropriate paperwork has been submitted and the parent has signed them out with the coach. Parents may only transport their own child.
