### BYLAWS

# of Westminster High School Baseball Inc., A California Nonprofit Corporation

#### **ARTICLE I - ORGANIZATION**

Section 1: The name of this organization is Westminster High School Baseball Inc., a California Nonprofit Corporation, hereinafter referred to as WHSB. WHSB is a California nonprofit, public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes and is operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

Section 2: The organization's office address shall be 14325 Goldenwest Street, Westminster, CA 92683.

Section 3: The Internal Revenue Service has assigned the Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN) of 84-3097236 for this organization.

Section 4: WHSB will file for tax-exempt status under applicable federal and state tax codes.

<u>Section 5:</u> WHSB will operate on a fiscal year from June to May annually. For its initial year of incorporation, WHSB shall have a short tax year.

#### ARTICLE II - PURPOSE AND ACTIVITIES

<u>Section 1:</u> The purpose of this organization shall be to support the high school baseball program of Westminster High School, Westminster, California by fundraising to cover the costs of uniforms, hats, sports gear, events and activities of the Westminster High School baseball program.

Section 2: Fundraising shall include, but not be limited to, the sales of advertising, banners, discount cards, Christmas trees, etc. to support the purpose of WHSB.

#### ARTICLE III - BASIC PROVISIONS

Section 1: The organization is dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other individuals. The assets and income shall only be used in accordance with the purposes set forth in Article II above. Nothing contained herein, however, shall be deemed to prohibit the payment of reasonable compensation to independent contractors for services provided for the benefit of the organization and to officers and members for reimbursable expenses of the organization.
