Medals

The events order will include medal presentations. Medal presentation format includes the coach with the winning team in that event presenting the medals. Each presentation will be immediately following that event.

<u>Admission</u>

Adults -- \$6.00 Students -- \$4.00 Administrators will be admitted free.

We will be allowing 2 spectators per participant to attend. Please submit a list of those names to us by Friday, February 12 at Noon.

Entrance

Teams and fans can enter through the main entrance of Newton High School (Door #1) located at the south end of the building. Buses can park at the south end of the parking lot.

Hospitality Room

A hospitality room will be provided up the stairs by the entrance in the athletic office area.

Locker Rooms

Locker rooms are available but limited. Please remind your swimmers to bring their own towels and each school is responsible for their own valuables.

Team Camps/Spectator Seating

All teams will camp/stage in the commons area. We ask that teams find a spot where their team can space out together. We will have all spectators sit in the main gym bleachers throughout the meet. We will announce each event to come to the pool. At that time only swimmers for that event, and only the spectators of those swimmers, may come to the pool. After each event is complete and awards are done we will clear everyone out of the pool to call the next event in. This will help us keep proper social distancing and not overcrowd the pool bleachers.

Entries

Please email your entries directly to Brian Becker (brian.becker@usd373.org) by Thursday, Feb. 11th at 10:00 pm. Entries will be in Hy-Tek zip file format. **No changes will be permitted unless the swimmer is listed as an alternate for that event.**

"SET UP" your Team Manager meet to include event 5 as 11 Dives.

Each team may enter four (4) swimmers in individual events and one (2) teams in each relay event. Only one relay team may score, so please mark the non-scoring relay as exhibition. Each swimmer and diver will be allowed to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. Please use your maximum entries setup on your team manager file before you start in-putting the entry data.

Make sure you enter the correct school for which each athlete is enrolled. Following the same format as State Championship entries, athletes from league member schools will compete only for the high school in which they are enrolled.

Any non-league swimmer or diver, from a non-league high school, who has been a member of a league team, has the opportunity to participate for an officially recognized KSHSAA time or diving score, but may not participate in any event for league points. Non-league swimmers may not be relay team members of the host school. All non-league athletes will be entered as EX in Team Manager entry files and will be seeded into the individual events. It would be a good idea to include a separate note listing those swimmers/divers, their schools, and their events along with your e-mail entry file for the host team.

Diving

Diving will consist of 11 dives according to Rule 9-4-1. We will cut to 20 divers after the 5th round of diving and we will cut to 16 after the 8th round of diving according to rules 9-4-4 and 9-4-5. Each school with a diver should provide a judge.

<u>Live-Stream</u>

We will have two separate live stream feeds on the Newton Athletics Facebook page. One will cover lanes 1-3, the other will cover lanes 4-6.

COVID Considerations:

All workers, players, coaches, spectators, and officials should social distance as much as possible. Masks are required to be worn properly at all times by everyone unless actually competing in the meet. Swimmers should keep their mask on until they are ready to get on the starting blocks and should put them back on before leaving the start area and entering the bleachers again.

We will have chairs behind the starting block for swimmers to set their towels and masks on prior to swimming.
