



## **La Costa Canyon Softball Gameday Protocol Information**

Welcome to LCC Softball! We would like to share COVID game day information with you regarding our upcoming game. We will be abiding by the Health and Safety guidelines put out by CIFSDS for the sport of Softball.

### **CIF HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES**

The Visiting team is responsible for the screening of their student-athletes before the contest.

**(Home contest site is not responsible for screening visiting athletes and coaches) Any student-athlete with positive symptoms reported should not be allowed to participate, should self-isolate, and contact their primary care provider or other health care professional**

### **Game time is 3:30**

The Visiting Team may arrive **by 2pm** and enter the field via the front entrance to the school. Please use the main parking lot, located at 1 Maverick Way, Carlsbad, CA 92009

We ask that your entire team arrive and enter together. The visitor side entry will be open, located to the left side, when facing the gym, labeled VISITOR. Walk down the stairs to softball field.

**MASKS are required once ON CAMPUS**

- ❖ The team should come fully dressed as locker rooms will be closed.
- ❖ **Masks are required for all participants, all coaches.**
- ❖ **Spectators are allowed and must wear a mask and maintain 6 feet of social distancing from non-immediate household fans. Only immediate household members may attend the**

games. Limited to two per household/player. Stands are taped off.

- ❖ LCC Athletic Trainer, Matt Scanlin will be on site for the game. Athletic Training services for visiting teams will be for acute injuries sustained during the game only. Athletes who need taping should be taped by their school's athletic trainer before traveling to the game.
- ❖ Restrooms will be available before and during the game.
- ❖ No handshakes before or at the conclusion of the game.
- ❖ The pregame conference is limited to one captain and one coach with the umpires and they must maintain social distancing.
- ❖ Teams should plan on bringing their own water.
- ❖ Team personnel and game administration should wash or sanitize their hands as often as possible.
- ❖ Visiting team MUST bring balls for game for their time on defense.
- ❖ At the end of the game, we kindly ask that spectators exit the field immediately and wait for their student-athlete's in the car, in the parking lot. The visiting team can remain 15 minutes after to stretch and cool down, as needed, and then exit.
