Eastern Conference Statement Regarding Expeditions at Playoff Contests

ONTARIO, CALIF. - The first round of the playoffs is set to begin in a few days; let's make this an enjoyable experience for our student-athletes. I would like to congratulate all the teams entering into the playoffs, especially, those teams that are playing in the conference for the first time; great job! It's Playoff Time – I don't need to say any more than it's playoff time! Huge games. One team advances and one team's season ends. With that stated there are some housekeeping issues that need to be addressed.

Over the past several weeks there has been a disturbing trend exhibited across our Conference; activities of sideline staff violation, threats fighting, and threats of retaliatory actions that have disrupted, postponed and cancelled games due to inappropriate behavior, both on the field and in the stands and parking lots. These actions have NO PLACE on our Conference.

While the Conference applauds the actions and steps taken by our Chapters to prevent a reoccurrence of such disappointing behavior, it is appropriate to remind all of our Chapters of the Operating Policies, Regulations and Playing Rules of as we begin the playoff season.

Conference reserves the right to deny a Chapter participation in Playoff/Championship Games regardless of their status as qualifiers if these important standards are not met or if rules are violated.

Everyone involved in competition including parent(s)/guardian(s)/caregiver, spectators, Chapter Staff, and all members of the Conference have a duty to honor the traditions of the sport and to treat other participants with respect. Coaches have a special responsibility to model respectful behavior and the duty to demand that their student-athletes refrain from disrespectful conduct including verbal abuse of opponents and officials, profane or belligerent trash-talking, taunting and inappropriate celebrations; There will be a ZERO TOLERANCE for these actions.

The Director of Football Operations and/or Executive Board shall have power to suspend, to fine or otherwise penalize any Chapter for the violation of any Conference rules and regulations or for just cause.

If a rule is not covered by our rule book, then The National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) the body that writes the rules of competition for most high school sports in the United States rules will be the controlling rules.

Playoff admission is as follows: \$7 for anyone over the age of 12, \$4 for anyone between the ages of 5 and 11, free for anyone under the age 5, as well as, players in their team jersey or cheerleaders in the cheer tops; it must a recognizable team uniform from our league. Presidents and the Chapter AD are exempt. Only individuals on the 8-person team roster for the team competing are exempt.

Only coaches and staff wearing a current 2018 field access passes will be allowed on the field. Only staff members permitted on the field during each division must be identified as Division Staff that is currently playing.

A full snack bar available throughout the day at each hosting site. No personal coolers or outside food/drink will be allowed on fields. Please support hosting fields snack bars.

NEW FOR 2018 PLAYOFFS

- ✓ All participants must receive their minimum mandatory number of plays by the end of the 3rd quarter.
- ✓ Any participant that has not received their minimum plays by the end of the 3rd quarter must enter the game and remain in the game until they have received their required number of plays.
- ✓ Spotter (opponent staff) will hold clipboard and track mandatory plays for opposing team.
- ✓ Assistant spotters are to assist head spotter by calling players numbers or assisting with identifying players coming on or off the field.
- ✓ Any player or coach ejected from a game for fighting will be disqualified from the reminder of the playoffs and all post season contests.

REMINDERS

- ✓ SCEYFL-AAU Conference twelve (12) minute quarters for all divisions.
- ✓ Play Clock: 30 second play clock enforced.
- ✓ Chain crews shall be provided by the home team.
- ✓ The chain crew shall consist of adults (no one under 18 years of age) whenever possible.
- ✓ Chain crews may be located on either side of the field, opposite of the press box is desired.
- ✓ The same crews should be maintained throughout the season so as to assure more efficient performance.
- ✓ The chain crew shall take their post at least five (5) minutes prior to time for the kick-off.
- ✓ Each site is required to provide vest identifying the chain crew during the game. Section 30.04 Chain crews must wear yellow, orange or green vest during regulation play.

PLAYOFF CHECK-IN

Check-in times for the Rookie games will be no later than 7:30 am (9:30am Antelope Valley Site), the rest of the games will be no later than the 3rd quarter of the prior game scheduled game time. Check-in located will be identified at arrival at each site.

All documents must be present for check inn. This includes the following:

- 1. Original Redline Rosters* with Red Playoff Certification stamp
- 2. AAU cards (must stamped by conference)
- 3. Copies of Government Identification Cards for your Jr. Varsity and Varsity players
- 4. Copies of your current redline rosters must be provided before half time to the opposing team

^{*}All redline rosters should be fixed before November 4th: Teams books should be available with certified paperwork if verification is required.
