<u>General Info</u>

All teams must check in at the results table prior to their first match. An up-to-date roster with a <u>certified adult</u> must be turned in prior to the start of the tournament. Only Sports Engine rosters will be accepted. Teams are responsible for providing their own warm-up balls. No trainer is on site for the tournament. Play begins at 8:30 am. There is NO coaches meeting. Please familiarize yourself with the tournament guidelines prior to your first match. Questions can be answered at the results table.

There will be an **admission fee** of **\$5 for adults** and **\$3 for students**. No charge for rostered adults and players. Everyone should enter through the west doors marked "Tournament Entrance". Everyone should park in the lower lot by the baseball field.

Doors open at 8:00 am and play begins at 8:30 am. Games will be played continuously. Playing times after the first match are approximate. Coaches, please be aware of the previous match so your team is on the court when they are scheduled to work or play. We will play ahead of schedule. Please have your teams ready to work and play your match as soon as the previous match has finished.

Teams and spectators are **NOT allowed on the 2nd level**, **including the track.** Rec Center staff will ask violators to leave the facility. If you would like to be on the track you must purchase a day pass at the Community Centre desk.

Absolutely **NO Coolers and NO outside food** allowed. A concessions stand will be available. This is strictly enforced by the facility.

Teams camps should be set up in the concessions stand room. NO team camps allowed on the 2nd level, including the track. Teams are responsible for cleaning up their team camp area before they leave the facility. This is strictly enforced. Please be respectful of our facility.

Lawn chairs are allowed. Seating is also available. DO NOT move team camps to set up chairs.

Good sportsmanship will be emphasized by all participants and spectators. Anyone choosing not to follow this guideline will be asked to leave the facility. Per Iowa Region policy, tournament results and format questions will only be discussed with rostered coaches and team reps only.

Tournament Guidelines:

Warm up for each team's first match is 10 minutes (2-4-4). After each team has played its first match warm-up will be 3-3 format, no shared ball handling. No ball handling is permitted by teams not on the court. No shared hitting.

Pool matches will be 2 sets to 25 starting at 4-4 with no cap, must win by 2.

All playoff matches will be the best 2 of 3 to 25 starting at 4-4. Game 3 will be played to 15 must win by 2 starting at 0-0 no cap. Teams will NOT switch sides. To start and end the match teams should stand on the end line and wave after whistle.

For all pool matches teams may have a junior as the R1 but a certified adult must be positioned next to the ref stand, be the R2 or be supervising the table.

A certified adult must be the 1st referee for all play-off matches during bracket play.

Cell phones, electronic devices, food and drink are **NOT** permitted at the scorer's table! This includes adults helping at the table. Stop watches will be provided at each table. Only certified adults are allowed to help with reffing responsibilities.

Tournament positioning will be determined by 1.) set record, 2.) head-to-head, 3.) point differential 5.) coin flip.

All teams will advance to bracket play.

10 medals will be awarded to the 1st place team of the tournament.
