MAROONS BASEBALL CLUB STAFF TRANSPORTATION POLICY

In any case that Maroons Baseball Club Staff are asked or have to transport players the following policy will be followed:

Policy:

- The driving staff member(s) will have a valid driver's license on file with the MBC directors.
- The number of staff members and players will not exceed the allotted number of people that can safely be transported.
- There will be all efforts made to have two adult-age staff members in the transport vehicle when player(s) are being transported by staff, although under some circumstances this may not always be possible.
- There will be all efforts made to have a minimum of one staff member of the same sex as the player(s) being transported.
- Pick-ups and drop-offs should be made at a public, neutral site such as the high school, if possible. Parents/guardians are responsible for punctual pick-up and drop-off.
- Requests for staff transport may be made a **minimum of one day prior** to game day. Requests must be submitted via email, by a parent/guardian, which will also act as permission for transportation.
- This policy does not apply to the transportation of biological, immediate family members of MBC staff and players.
- Only MBC staff and players are allowed to be transported by MBC staff.

Staff members are not financially liable for any costs, including possible food stops, of an MBC player. This policy has been issued to all players and parents/guardians. Any granted requests for transportation will be in accordance with the policy above. By utilizing any form of MBC staff transportation, non-MBC parties involved are agreeing to not sue the Maroons Baseball Club. The Maroons Baseball Club Staff holds the right to decline or reject any requests made at any time.

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
