#### This packet includes information about:

#### Upcoming summer rehearsals and camp

A required part of the Maine West band experience is the Marching Warriors. We start this experience for a few nights in June and a week in August to prepare new and returning members for a great year.

#### 2022 Rehearsal and Performance schedule

This 8-week season coincides with varsity football, including home games, some outside-of-school performances, and maybe even some community and recruitment events as well!

#### Fee Form and explanations of needed costs/purchases

Similar to some other Maine West ensembles and activities, the Marching Warriors requires a flat fee to cover all costs for the students each fall season. Fundraising is made available to students to help lower costs.

#### **Instrument Rental Form**

This one-time annual fee of \$50.00 is paid by all percussionists and any other students using Maine West equipment. This cost covers the repairs and maintenance of our inventory that you would pay if you owned your own instruments.

## Marching Band 2022-2023 Costs

There are necessary costs to run a quality program such as ours. There is no school budget for marching band. All costs below are payable online through Infinite Campus, and in the bookstore via cash, credit/debit cards, or checks to "Maine West HS".

### NEW MEMBERS = \$185.00 SOPHOMORES, JUNIORS AND SENIORS = \$160.00

#### This flat payment includes:

- Uniform t-shirt & baseball cap for all. Long sleeve T & athletic shorts for new members (under uniform)
- Supplemental materials/supplies for season, including drawstring backpacks and flip folio pages
- Staffing costs for more small group attention throughout the summer and fall season
- Production costs such as visual marching design, music arranging costs, props for competition show, etc
- Costs for exhibition event judges/clinicians
- Dinner cost during August 6th band camp

# **Marching Warriors Cost Explanations**

## **Uniform T-Shirt, Long Sleeve T, Shorts and Hat!**

All new members will receive a uniform T-shirt, whereas new members (frosh/sophomore) will also receive a long sleeve T-shirt and shorts as well. These are to be worn underneath uniforms at performances. This allows us to ALWAYS look uniform in rehearsal for drill cleaning, as well as to cool off on warmer performance events. Students receive a new t-shirt each year to add to their "collection" to avoid constant washing. A custom baseball cap for new members is also included in fees, as they are worn in the stands during games and events when we take off our marching band hats.

### **Marching Band Shoes**

There are **specific** shoes used for marching band, similar to wearing cleats for a sport. ALL members must have a pair of these shoes. The brand shoe is the **Drillmaster Marching Shoe**. They will be delivered to students before the first home game. Returning members may also purchase new shoes in case of growth. **There is a place on the fee form to order a pair to add to your fee total.** 

### **Staffing and Production Costs**

Our department brings in many private instructors and staff to work with students on their specific instruments in a group setting. Some staff continue to work with us through the entire marching band season. This is the equivalent to having assistant coaches in athletics. The cost covers this instruction from some of the finest musicians and teachers in the Chicagoland area! Students may continue with private individual lessons when the school year begins. There are also costs that are not covered by the district's budget, such as marching routine design and special music arrangements that we have composed for our season.

#### The undersigned agrees to the following terms:

1. That the property herein described belonging to Maine Township High School District 207 is loaned to the student during his membership in or preparations for one or more of the instrumental organizations sponsored by the Maine West High School Fine Arts Department.

- 2. Student receiving the said instrument or property listed agrees:
  - (a) To assume full responsibility for instrument or equipment loaned to him and keep it clean and in good repair.
  - (b) To refuse to loan the instrument/equipment to anyone without express permission from chairman of the music department. (When two or more students are assigned to use an instrument vis: a string bass, cello or drums the music director will make special arrangements governing the use of such equipment.)
  - (c) To improve his musicianship:
    - (1) by practicing a reasonable amount of time each day;
    - (2) by taking private or group lessons as recommended by his instructor;
    - (3) by regular attendance at all rehearsals and programs whenever called upon to do so by instructor

#### (d) To pay a rental fee of \$50.00 per school year.

(The school year is understood to mean the actual number of days the school is in session during any 10- month period.)

I have read the foregoing conditions governing the property loaned to me. I have examined the instrument and property and find it to be in good condition. For the privilege of using the instrument or equipment, I hereby subscribe and pledge myself to all the conditions herein stated.

\* If it is determined that damage to the instrument was caused by student negligence, a meeting will be set with the family, teacher and department chair to discuss replacement.

\*\* percussionists do not need to fill out make/serial number/value, just list Percussion as instrument

\*\*\* for non-percussionists: if renting an instrument, please know that after a year in the department, families should be making arrangements to purchase or rent-to-own a personal instrument. A woodwind or brass student should not be renting an instrument for more than a year. If there are other circumstances, those will be discussed on a case-by-case basis.

# What do all members need for Marching Band?

## Instrument:

# - Flute, Clarinet, Alto Sax, Tenor Sax, Trumpet, Trombone:

You should bring your own instrument. If you have a second instrument, use the "less nice" instrument – i.e. use your plastic clarinet not the wooden clarinet.

## - Horn/Mellophone, Euphonium/Baritone, Tuba, Percussion

We will provide you with a marching instrument. Bring your mouthpiece please.

# Woodwinds and Brass:

- Head to Quinlan and Fabish, Amazon.com or your favorite music store to purchase the appropriate flip folder and lyre for your instrument. Their sales reps can help you with questions. You will receive LOTS of music to put into your flip folios.

# Attire/Needed supplies:

## 1 - Comfortable clothes and shoes

You will always wear comfortable gym shoes and socks, NEVER flip flops or sandals. T-shirts and shorts are fine, but always appropriate in length and design/content. Sunglasses and a hat are definitely a good idea through the season and weather changes.

- 2 A **water bottle** in the heat is a MUST-have.
- 3 Please make sure you always have a **pencil** handy to make changes in music and drill. This is very important for what we do. Put it in your case or backpack.
- 4 All students must have **1-1.5 inch three ring binder** Woodwinds/brass use it for drill, percussion uses it for music

# Backpack/Drawstring Pack:

 Freshman will receive a Marching Warriors drawstring backpack in the fall. (sophomores, juniors and seniors have theirs from previous years) An easy way to keep things together and not leave anything behind/forgotten. Similar to what you would do for a fall sport.
