PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Introduction

The Maroons Baseball Club is dedicated to the development of our youth to be the best well-rounded young adults and best baseball players both on and off the field. “*Heart, Hustle, Together*” is the motto MBC thrives on, to give it your all, give it your best, and do it as a community.

Communication

- We encourage open communication between all program members including players, coaches, directors, parents/guardians, volunteers, and our community.
- Should a player have any form of concern or question that relates to their personal place on the team, the player will notify a staff member of the need to speak with them. Staff members will ensure that time will be made for that player. The player should address their topic appropriately and respectfully with that designated staff member. Should they feel that they have not been heard or they need to address to a higher level the player and parents will contact a program director to address the topic.
- Should a situation or point of concern that involves the well-being and/or health of any person, a player will contact a staff member immediately or ask for help to get the necessary parties involved.
- Conflicts between teammates should be made aware to coaches immediately and addressed.

Player's Code of Conduct

- Players will follow the program model of *Heart, Hustle, Together*.
- Players will arrive on time (15 minutes) prior to the start of practice and at designated times for games and other events that could range closer to an hour.
- Players understand that baseball is a team sport and any absences from practices, games, and team events affect the overall team. In such an event that a player will not be at an event, the proper staff representative(s) must be notified in a timely manner.
- Players will treat all involved parties with respect regardless of race, religion, color, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, or ability.

- Players will acknowledge the knowledge, effort, and dedication to the game of the umpire(s) at the conclusion of a game.
- Players will congratulate the other team after each game because they should be celebrated for their accomplishments as well.
- Players will do everything to support their teammates and applaud the efforts and accomplishments of players on both teams.
- Players will provide a positive attitude to learn, grow, support, and have fun at all times.
- Players will dedicate themselves to the positive representation of our community and program at all times.

Drugs, Tobacco, and Alcohol Policy

Use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco will result in automatic suspension of the player with a heavy penalty to be determined by a mandatory meeting with the MBC directors.

Repercussions

Any player found in violation of the Player's Code of Conduct as seen above may be subject to:

- Benching.
- Suspension from current and/or future contests or events.
- Appearance before the Maroons Baseball Club Directors to determine disciplinary action.
- Temporary or permanent expulsion from any or all MBC events.

Communication

- Should an event occur where there are high emotions involved or any form of tension, parents and guardians will adhere to the “24-Hour Cooling Off Policy” before contacting any staff members unless immediate harm is present.
- Parents and Guardians will not confront coaches or staff members at any time during a game pending an emergency.
- Parents and Guardians will not confront coaches about a player's playing time.

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- Parents/Guardians will follow the program model of *Heart, Hustle, Together*.
- Parents/Guardians will strive to have players on time (15 minutes) prior to the start of practice and at designated times for games and other events that could range closer to an hour. MBC staff members do understand that different circumstances may occur.
 - **MBC holds the right to hold “closed to spectator” practices should MBC staff choose to do so.*
- Parents/Guardians understand that baseball is a team sport and any player absences from practices, games, and team events affect the overall team. In such an event that a player will not be at an event, the proper staff representative(s) must be notified in a timely manner.
