

Player Expectations

- Be on time to ALL practices
- Must attend every practice
- Please communicate with your coach about any reason you will be late to practice/ or miss a practice. DO NOT TELL ANOTHER PLAYER TO TELL COACH
- If you miss a practice without notifying a coach, it will be unexcused





Player Expectations

Unexcused Absences:

- One unexcused absence will result in a one game suspension
- Two unexcused absences will result in a 2 game suspension
- Three unexcused absences can result in dismissal from the team.



Player Expectations

Late Practices (5:00 pm)

- Go home and return on time- Car pool!
- Players are not allowed to hang around in the school or the FH balcony.
- Players may wait in the Boys' Basketball locker room or join a study group in Mr. Pettis classroom. (Room 112)
- Do homework or just relax. Be respectful of others.



School Attendance

- Must be at School by 11 AM in order to practice
- School sponsored events that take you out of school are excused
- Doctor / College visits are excused

Injuries



- Report Injury to coach.
- Coach recommends if you should see trainer.
- Trainer recommends if you should see Dr.
- Once you see a doctor, only the doctor can give you clearance to play (Written).



Transportation

- Bus times on BHS Basketball and Northwest Suburban websites
- Players required to ride bus to contest, encouraged to ride home with team on bus.
- Players not riding home on the bus will need a signed note from a parent.
- Players are never allowed to ride home with others- only legal guardians.





Uniform Care

- Players responsible for washing uniforms.
- Clean uniforms regularly, do not dry.
- Wash in cold water and DO NOT USE BLEACH!

Playing Time

1 Earned Every Practice/Game

Will be determined by practice and game play. Hard work, performance, coachability, etc..

2 Players Talk to Coaches

All players are encouraged to talk to coaches when needing feedback regarding playing time..

3 Parents Meeting Upon Request

24 hour rule for contacting coaches. If a parent requests to meet with coach, the player must be present.

Want to play at the next Level?



- 3.1% senior high school players (less than 1 in 35) end up on teams in college.
- 2% Receive some form of scholarship money for Basketball
- 1.2% senior basketball players in college (1 in 75) are drafted by a National Basketball Association team.
- .03% of high school basketball players (3 in 10,000) will eventually be drafted by an NBA team.

LETTERING POLICY (VARSITY ONLY)

Varsity Lettering : A player can earn a varsity letter one of the following ways:

- A letter will be awarded if a varsity player has perfect attendance throughout the season.
- A letter will be awarded to every player who is a member of a state tournament team.
- A letter will be awarded to a player who has seen action in 12 varsity games.
- A letter will be awarded to a player who is deemed deserving by the coaching staff and athletic director but did not meet the above criteria due to extraordinary circumstances.
- NOTE: A player must finish the season in good standing with the coaching staff.
- Final decisions on letters are up to coaches' discretion

Desirable Parent Behavior

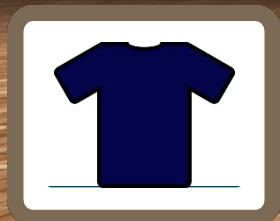
- Supportive

Supports various opportunities for team-building and celebration; fan and staff appreciation, youth night, parent night, senior recognition and end-of season banquet



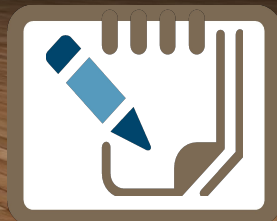
We outfit the players with travel gear, shooting shirts and related items.

Booster Club Meetings

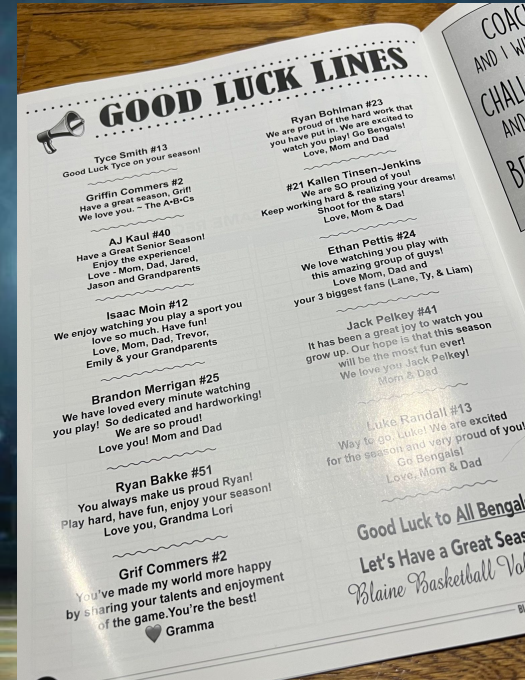



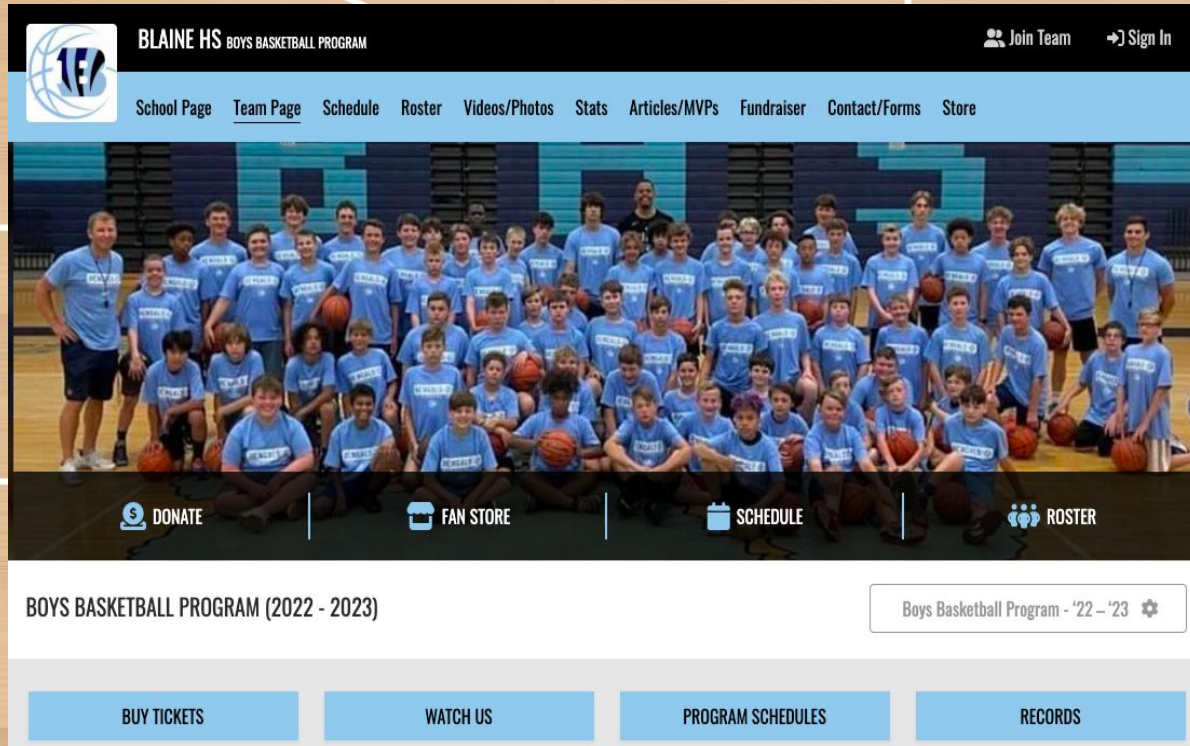
