

## Victory at Vail 2023 Series Race #3

Middle School: Saturday, March 11<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 PM High School: Sunday, March 12<sup>th</sup> at 9:45 AM Vail Lake Resort, Temecula, CA

#### **IMPORTANT:**

Daylight savings time begins at 2:00 AM on Sunday. Don't forget to set your clocks forward one hour!!!

**DESCRIPTION:** A roller coaster of twists and turns mixing moderate punchy climbs, swoopy singletrack, and fire road passing areas that dips in and out of cheering crowds. One middle school lap is approximately 3.6 miles. One high school lap is approximately 5.5. One Varsity Lap is approximately 6.7 miles.

**PRE-RIDE:** All riders are strongly encouraged to pre-ride the course. Pre-ride of the whole course is open Saturday from 11:00 AM-2:00 PM (riders can session the parts of the high school course NOT on the middle school course after 2:00 PM but please leave the middle school course clear for racing) and Sunday from 7:30-9:00 AM. **Pre-ride with map and identification.** 

**DIRECTIONS:** From Highway 15 at Temecula, take highway 79 South 9 miles to Vail Lake Resort. There is a per-vehicle gate charge for non-camping vehicles. PLEASE review venue map for parking areas!

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Camping at the race venue. The Campsites at Vail Lake are surrounded by shady Oak trees and acres of beautiful desert scenery. Our event will be held in open area adjacent to the jump track located just west of the Lower Merlot Mesa Camp area. Contact Vail Lake reservations at (951) 303-0173. Website <a href="koa.com/campgrounds/temecula/">koa.com/campgrounds/temecula/</a>. There are full amenities for campers including hot showers. There are many hotels within 15 miles of Vail Lake Resort if you are not a camper. The hotels are located off the 15 highway near exits Rancho California and the South 79.

**FOOD SERVICE:** Selections might include: Chicken Shack, Chespiroz, D's Coffee, Nichos Ice Cream, Saturday & Sunday Lunch and Sunday breakfast. Food is also available in the camp Village which has a bar, general store, and café.

**IMPORTANT VENUE INFORMATION:** Vail Lake features a labyrinth of incredible intersecting trail systems. While we encourage you to explore and enjoy all that Vail has to offer on race weekend please know that league medical staff are only available during certain times and will prioritize our event course and venue as shown on the venue map. Please ride with care and be on the lookout for other riders at all times. If you are riding at any time or in any other place other than the race course/infield area outside of pre-ride or your race know that you are on your own!

NEUTRAL SUPPORT: Unchained Bicycle Garage (www.unchainedbicyclegarage.com for more info) will be on hand providing Neutral Support. They can provide mechanical assistance prior to your race start. Please do not abuse Neutral Support! Neutral Support is for emergency fixes of bikes ONLY! Neutral support is NOT a place to bring poorly maintained bikes for free work. If mechanics staffing Neutral Support believe your fix is not an emergency they may contact the Race Director who may have your bike removed from Neutral Support. Mechanics staffing Neutral Support may work on non-emergency fixes for a fee if time is available.

**REGISTRATION:** Early registration online ends Tuesday 2/21/23 at 11:59 PM. Late registration begins online on Wednesday 2/22/23 at 12:01 AM and continues online until approximately one hour prior to race start. Late registration incurs an additional \$10-time preference fee. **NEW THIS YEAR**: you can pay your registration online at the race venue IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A PLATE. You do not need to go to the Registration booth and wait in line. Please remember that participating in a race without having paid for the race may result in race disqualification

In-person, late registration (for those wanting to pay with check or cash) will be available on-site at the race venue starting Saturday 2/25/23 at approximately noon and Sunday 2/26/23 at approximately 8:00 AM.

Race plates are **TO BE KEPT AND USED ALL SEASON**. Replacement plates cost \$10 and are available on-site at the Registration Tent. If you have not yet received your race plate this season you may pick it up at the registration tent during operating hours.
